Kendal Structure

Kendal is structured on what is referred to as a *federal model*. Each Affiliate within the Kendal System is locally governed and operated by an independent non-profit board of directors. The Kendal Corporation offers expertise and support to Affiliates, individually and collectively.

The Affiliate structure provides the best of both worlds: an understanding of unique local environments and circumstances combined with the advantages of being part of a larger nationwide system of support.

When referring to communities and services provided by The Kendal Corporation, we use terms such as "the Kendal System" or "Kendal". Per Kendal's Quaker values, we respect the individuality and autonomy of Kendal communities, residents, Kendal at Home members and employees. In turn, Kendal does not use possessive terminology such as "our" campus or "our" residents or "its" employees.

• Kendal Approach to Health and Wellness

Preferred Terminology

Guided by Quaker Values, Kendal avoids using terminology that minimizes a person's individuality, portrays an institutional model or may come across as infantilizing or ageist, when referring to people, communities, and services within the Kendal System.

Aging in place	Staying at home, growing older at home, Life Plan at Home
Alzheimer's or dementia unit	Memory support area or residence; or use the name of the area
Dining program	Restaurant, café, bistró, dining venue, or call it by name
Disabled	Person with (name of condition)
Facility	Community, campus, accommodations, neighborhood, residences
Independent living	Residential living
"Our" community	The community, cite name of community
"Our" residents	The residents, the people who live here, community members
Nursing home, The Home, SNF	Health care center, health care residences, skilled nursing center, rehabilitation services, name of area
Project	Community, campus, name of community

Put, place, placement	Move, join the community, become a member/resident of the campus
Senior, senior citizen	People, person, individual, person 62 plus, mature adult, older adult
Senior Living Industry	Field of senior living and aging services
Unit	Home, residence, apartment home, cottage, accommodation, neighborhood
